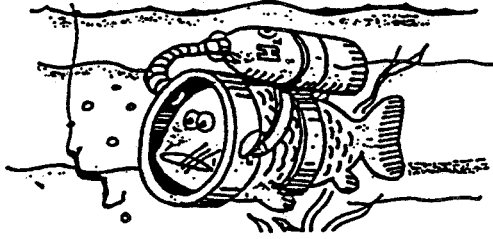


GET WET!
